

# FR. MARK'S NOTES

## **A Vision Moving Forward**

Today's parents are forced to be always on the watch, always seeking what is best for their children like never before. God Bless you; it's harder than ever before to be a parent. Thank you for taking on this awesome and sacred task.

I went to church as a kid because everyone went. Now, things are different-very different. How can we, in new ways, excite our children about the faith? But first, how can we, the adults, get excited about our faith? Here in our spiritual home, do we have the remedy they need, and that we need too? So, we really need a vision that can help us move forward positively. We need a strategy that will move us as a parish so we can begin seeing this faith of ours in whole new ways.
