

FATHER MARK'S NOTES

Last week I mentioned that we would soon not have one but three adult education classes between the 8:30 and the 11:00 Masses. I now have more information to share with you. First, on October 24, we will begin a men's group led by Brian Koch and Matt DiFrancesco. The class is for men between the ages of 25 and 45; who have children in our religious education program. They will meet in Holy Grounds. This group is for young men, dads, and husbands.

The second group, led by Norman Ed and Sean O'Dowd, will be for anyone who wishes to meet on a series of faith topics. This group will meet at the Mill House (open only for our discussion group) with an "OMOS discount" (50% off of your purchase) for coffee. But, again, all are welcome.

The third group will be the one that I presently teach. We will continue to meet in the church. We are finishing up with our book on Joseph and will soon be taking up the topic of the Mass, the Sacred Liturgy. The Sacred Liturgy, the Holy Mass, is critical to our faith, and we know so little about it. We want to explore all that more in-depth.

Now, let me briefly explain what I said to all of you about my history of religious education. I, of course, had religious education in my school years. It helped me get through those critical days of growing up, but it never allowed me to answer any of my questions about life and faith as an adult. That training WASN'T MEANT TO DO THAT!! It was to help me as a kid – and it did. Now, I have adult questions. How do I answer the adult questions with the religious education of a kid? I need adult religious education!! We all do.

So, join us!! Three options, and if we need more, we will offer them. God Bless you all, feel welcomed and let's all keep growing in our life of faith through Sunday Mass, small groups, daily prayer, Scripture reading, and adult education. Let's pack each place.
